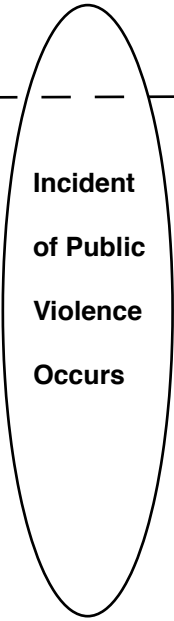

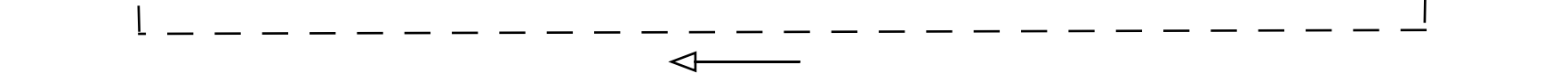

The **Public Violence Resilience Action Plan** is a new Whole Community approach to address public violence and prevent future incidents. The new plan includes: a Public Violence Resilience Coalition; a Public Violence Resilience Plan; community and leadership training; community-specific programs addressing the impacts of violence; an integrated Public Violence-specific Messaging and Social Media Plan; and intentional collaboration between the Coalition, Emergency Management and Public Health/government agencies. Leadership continuity for the Coalition may come from local government or other local leaders. The action plan incorporates faith-based and human services nonprofits into planning and responding to public violence with a goal of restoring healthy and resilient communities. While the best approach is to plan in advance, it is possible to implement all or parts the plan in response to an incident. It can also be implemented when a community is on tenterhooks following a series of smaller incidents and is fearful that a major incident will take place.
